<u>Attachment – Additional Statements – Liability and Indemnification</u>

The liability of the directors of the corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated to the fullest extent permissible under California law.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, this corporation shall indemnify its directors, officers, employees and other persons described in Section 317(a) of the California Corporations Code, including persons formerly occupying any such positions, against all expenses, judgments, fines, settlement and other amounts actually and reasonably incurred by them in connection with any "proceeding," as that term is used in that section, and including an action by or in the right of this corporation, by reason of the fact that the person is or was a person described in that section. "Expenses," as used in this Article, shall have the same meaning as in that section of the California Corporations Code.

Any repeal or modification of this Article shall only be prospective and shall not affect the rights under this Article in effect at the time of the alleged occurrence of any act or omission to act giving rise to liability or indemnification.
