## CORPORATION NAME: JUSTICE FOR VICTIMS OF SEXUAL ABUSE ATTACHMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION TAX EXEMPTION STATUS - ADDITIONAL REQUIRED STATEMENT

This corporation is organized exclusively for social welfare purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code.

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to social welfare purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or private person.

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment or provision for payment of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for social welfare purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501 (c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code.
