- 7. The liability of the directors of the corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated to the fullest extent permissible under California law.
- 8. This corporation is authorized to provide indemnification of agents (as defined in Section 317 of the California Corporation Code) though bylaw provisions, agreements with agents, vote of shareholders or disinterested directors or otherwise, in excess of the indemnification otherwise permitted by Section 317 of the California Corporations Code, subject only to the applicable time limits set forth in Section 204 of the California Corporations Code with respect to actions for breach of duty to the corporation and its shareholders.
- 9. Any repeal or modification of the foregoing provisions of Sections 7 and 8 by the shareholders of this corporation shall not adversely affect any right or protection of an agent of this corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification.
