The liability of the director(s) of the corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated to the fullest extent permitted under California law.

Any repeal or modification of the foregoing provisions by the shareholders of the corporation shall not adversely affect any right or protection of an agent of the corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification.
