## ATTACHMENT: Additional Statements to Articles of Incorporation (Tax Exemption Status Section) for Guardians of Humanity's Charter

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for philanthropic social welfare purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code.

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to philanthropic social welfare purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private person.

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation that is organized and operated exclusively for philanthropic social welfare purposes and that has established its tax-exempt status under section 501(c)(3) or section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code.
