**Spiritual Assembly of the Bahá'ís of Palo Alto
Attachment**

The specific purpose of this corporation is for the establishment and maintenance of religious worship and spiritual activities in Palo Alto, California, in accordance with the principles of the Bahá'í Faith as set forth by Bahá'u'lláh, its Founder; 'Abdu'l-Bahá, its Interpreter and Exemplar; Shoghi Effendi, its Guardian; the Universal House of Justice, its supreme legislative body; and the National Spiritual Assembly of the Bahá'ís of the United States, the duly constituted administrative authority in and for the United States of America except the states of Alaska and Hawaii and all United States trusts and territories; and further for the doing of any and all things necessary and incident to the performance of the purposes set forth above insofar as the same are permissible under the statute governing this incorporation.

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to religious and charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision of payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to the National Spiritual Assembly of the Bahá'ís of the United States if then in existence, organized and operated exclusively for religious and charitable purposes and exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, but if not then in existence or so organized, operated and exempt, to another organization which is organized and operated exclusively for religious and charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
