Additional Statements

FinGERO, a California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation

The specific purpose of this corporation is to provide legal and financial information to older Americans and those who serve them in the interdisciplinary field of financial gerontology, emphasizing financial-economic and legal awareness and preparedness.

Notwithstanding any of the above statements of purpose and powers, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the specific purpose of this corporation.

This corporation is not organized for profit but operated exclusively for the promotion of social welfare and educational activities within the scope of Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future federal Internal Revenue Code law). No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not make any lobbying or grass roots expenditures within the meaning of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or any future federal Internal Revenue Code).

This corporation shall not engage in any "prohibited transaction," "political expenditure," act of "self-dealing," or any other activity that would jeopardize this corporation's status as a tax-exempt "social welfare" or educational organization under the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or any future federal Internal Revenue Code).

This corporation shall not engage in any trade or business activity.
