Attachment to Articles of Incorporation of Internet Freak, Inc.

Liability and Indemnification:

The liability of the directors of the corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated to the fullest extent permissible under California law.

The corporation is authorized to provide indemnification of agents (as defined in Corporations Code Section 317) for breach of duty to the corporation and its stockholders through bylaw provisions or through agreements with the agents, or both, in excess of the indemnification otherwise permitted by Corporations Code Section 317, subject to the limits on such excess indemnification set forth in Corporations Code Section 204.
