## ATTACHMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF BFM HOLDINGS, INC.

<u>Liability of Directors</u>. The liability of the directors of the corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated to the fullest extent permissible under California law.

<u>Indemnification</u>. The corporation is authorized to provide indemnification of agents (as defined in Section 317 of the California Corporations Code) for breach of duty to the corporation and its stockholders through bylaw provisions or through agreements with the agents, or both, in excess of the indemnification otherwise permitted by Section 317 of the California Corporations Code, subject to the limits on such excess indemnification set forth in Section 204 of the California Corporations Code.
