

Certificate of Dissolution of a Limited Liability Company (LLC)

To dissolve a California LLC, you can fill out this form, and submit for filing.

- There is no filing fee, however, a separate, non-refundable **\$15** service fee must be included, if you **drop off** the completed form.
- To file this form, the status of your LLC must be active on the records of the California Secretary of State. To check the status of the LLC, go to kepler.sos.ca.gov/.

Important! To complete the cancellation process, the LLC also must file a Certificate of Cancellation (Form LLC-4/7). Note: This Form LLC-3 is **not required** when the vote to dissolve was made by all of the members and that fact is noted on Form LLC-4/7.

Note: *Before submitting the completed form*, you should consult with a private attorney for advice about your specific business needs. It is recommended for proof of submittal that if this form is mailed, it be sent by Certified Mail with Return Receipt Requested.


