The activities of the Company are to further the charitable purposes of its Member, including but not limited to healthcare, to operate exclusively for the purposes set forth within the meaning of Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3) and are not for the private gain of any person.

The Company is organized as and shall remain a single member limited liability company.

In the event of dissolution, the Company shall conduct only such activities as are necessary to wind up its affairs (including the sale of the assets of the Company in an orderly manner), and the assets of the Company shall be applied as follows: (i) first, to creditors, to the extent otherwise permitted by law, in satisfaction of liabilities of the Company (whether by payment or the making of reasonable provision for payment thereof); and (ii) thereafter, to the Member so long as the Member is a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational and religious purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3) (a "*Charitable Transferee*") or to another Charitable Transferee if the Member does not then qualify as a Charitable Transferee at such time.
