This is to Certify: that pursuant to the provisions of An Act of the Legislature of the State of California entitled "An Act to create and organize the University of California" approved March ~~22d~~^{23d} A. D. 1868. the undersigned Henry H. Haight, Governor of the State of California William Holden Lieutenant Governor and O. S.
