ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ASIAN BUSINESS ASSOCIATION CALIFORNIA

I.

The name of this corporation is Asian Business Association California.

IT.

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public purposes.
- B. The specific purposes of this corporation are educating and outreaching to people regarding, mobilizing support for, and influencing policies to support Asian-American, Native-Hawaiian, and Pacific-Islander small businesses, and to strive to foster economic opportunity, equity, and a better quality of life for all Californians.

III.

IV.

V.

This corporation is organized exclusively for social welfare purposes within the meaning of Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(4) or the corresponding section of any future federal internal revenue law. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation, and the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(4) or the corresponding provision of any future federal internal revenue law, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Internal Revenue Code section 170(c)(2) or the corresponding provision of any future federal internal revenue law.

VI.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

VII.

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to the purposes in Article II herein and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, trustee, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private person.

VIII.

Upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts, obligations, and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for tax-exempt purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(4) and corresponding provisions of any future federal internal revenue law.
