Addendum/Attachment to Articles of Incorporation of RINK'S TOOL COMPANY, INC.

The following constitutes an addendum to the Articles of Incorporation of RINK'S TOOL COMPANY, INC. and is incorporated by this reference at the Section therein provided therefor.

<u>LIMITATION OF DIRECTORS' LIABILITY</u>: The liability of the Directors of the Corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated to the fullest extent permissible under California Law.

<u>EXPANDED INDEMNIFICATION</u>: The Corporation is authorized to provide indemnification of agents (as defined in Section 317 of the Corporations Code) through bylaw provisions, agreements with agents, vote of shareholders or disinterested directors or otherwise, in excess of the indemnification otherwise permitted by Section 317 of the Corporations Code, subject only to the applicable limits set forth in Section 204 of the Corporations Code with respect to actions for breach of duty to the Corporation and its stockholders.

<u>EFFECT OF REPEAL OR MODIFICATION</u>: Any repeal or modification of the foregoing provisions by the shareholders of this Corporation shall not adversely affect any right or protection of an agent of this Corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification.
