This corporation is authorized to issue only one class of shares of stock; and the total number of shares that this corporation is authorized to issue is ten thousand (10,000).

The liability of the directors of the corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated to the fullest extent permissible under California law. The corporation is authorized to provide indemnification of agents (as defined in Section 317 of the Corporations Code) for breach of duty to the corporation and its stockholders through bylaw provisions or through agreements with the agents, or both, in excess of the indemnification otherwise permitted by Section 317 of the Corporations Code, subject to

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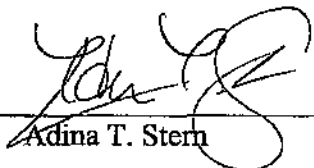
the limits of such excess in indemnification set forth in Section 204 of the Corporations Code.
