ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MELISSA J. PENZA, PHYSICAL THERAPIST CORPORATION

ARTICLE I NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of this corporation is Melissa J. Penza, Physical Therapist Corporation.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE OF CORPORATION

The purpose of the corporation is to engage in the profession of physical therapy and any other lawful activities (other than the banking or trust company business) not prohibited to a corporation engaging in such profession by applicable laws and regulations. This corporation is a professional corporation within the meaning of California Corporations Code §§13400 et seq.

ARTICLE III INITIAL AGENT FOR SERVICE OF PROCESS

This corporation's initial agent for service of process is San Diego Corporate Law, A Professional Law Corporation.

ARTICLE IV CORPORATE ADDRESSES

ARTICLE V CAPITALIZATION

- A. This corporation is authorized to issue only one class of shares, which shall be designated as "common" shares. The total number of such shares authorized to be issued is ten thousand (10,000) shares.
- B. This corporation is subject to the restrictions on the qualifications of shareholders imposed by California Corporations Code §13401.5 and other applicable laws, rules, and regulations, which provide that only the following may be shareholders of a physical therapy corporation:
 - (1) Holders of a valid license to practice physical therapy by the California Department of Consumer Affairs, Physical Therapy Board of California;
 - (2) The following licensed persons as defined by Corporations Code §13401.5(p) as long as the number of shares in the corporation owned by such persons does not exceed 49 percent of the total shares issued by the corporation and the number of such persons owning shares in the corporation does not exceed the number of licensed physical therapists owning shares in the corporation: (1) Licensed physicians and surgeons; (2) Licensed doctors of podiatric medicine; (3) Licensed acupuncturists; (4) Naturopathic doctors; (5) Licensed occupational therapists; (6) Licensed speech-language therapists; (7) Licensed audiologists; (8) Registered nurses; (9) Licensed psychologists; (10) Licensed physician assistants; and (11) Licensed midwives.

ARTICLE VI LIMITATIONS ON DIRECTOR LIABILITY

The liability of the directors of the corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated to the fullest extent permissible under California law.

ARTICLE VII DIRECTOR AND OFFICER INDEMNIFICATION

The corporation is authorized to provide indemnification of agents for breach of duty to the corporation and its shareholders through Bylaw provisions or through agreements with the agents, or both, in excess of the indemnification otherwise permitted by the Corporations Code 317, subject to the limits on such excess indemnification set forth in the Corporations Code 204(a)(11).
