AFFORDABLE HOUSING ACQUISITION FUND

Specific Purpose: This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, as those terms are defined in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”), including but not limited to the charitable purposes relief of the aged, poor, distressed, or underprivileged, lessening the burdens of government, and advancement of education or science. Such purposes will be furthered through activities which include but are not limited to the following: (i) accelerating the production and preservation of permanent and interim affordable housing for California’s very-low income, low income, middle income, and/or any other economically disadvantaged households and individuals, including the aged and students, by providing, developing, financing, constructing, rehabilitating, owning, and operating affordable housing for the benefit of such households and individuals; (ii) lessening the burdens of government to provide affordable permanent and interim housing to very-low income, low income, middle income, and/or any other economically disadvantaged households and individuals, including the aged and students, by providing, developing, financing, constructing, rehabilitating, owning, and operating affordable housing for the benefit of such households and individuals; and (iii) combatting homelessness through providing permanent and interim housing to such households and individuals.
