## ADDITIONAL STATEMENT I

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for social welfare purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code and within the meaning of Section 23701f of the California Revenue and Taxation Code.

## ADDITIONAL STATEMENT II

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to social welfare purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member (if any) of this corporation or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for social welfare purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code or a charitable organization which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
