Additional Statements, first paragraph – specific purpose, continued:

The corporation's purpose is to devote its funds, assets and resources to the active conduct of charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes within the meaning of § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Specifically, the corporation is organized to design, develop and construct housing for the sole use of the Kavli Institute for Theoretical Physics ("KITP"), a research institute that is part of the University of California, Santa Barbara. KITP is a scientific research facility where active researchers congregate, interact and collaborate to forge new directions in physics research. The development and construction of housing will facilitate KITP's charitable mission by providing housing for KITP's postdoctoral scholars, visiting graduate fellows, and long-term KITP visitors. KITP makes all of its scientific research accessible to the interested public via talks available online as well as public lectures.
