Additional Information:

The following is hereby added to the text of the Articles of Organization:

- “1. The Limited Liability Company is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes.
2. The Limited Liability Company is operated exclusively to further the charitable purposes of its member(s).
3. Each member of the Limited Liability Company shall be a qualifying organization, which is qualified for the welfare exemption under Section 214 of the California Revenue & Taxation Code (“R&T Code”) and is tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (the “Code”) or Section 23701d of the R&T Code (referred to herein as a “Qualifying Organization”).
4. No member shall transfer any direct or indirect membership interest in the Limited Liability Company to any person or entity which is not a Qualifying Organization.
5. The property of the Limited Liability Company is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes.
6. Upon dissolution, all assets shall be distributed to an organization(s) organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes, as specified in Section 214 of the R&T Code, and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or under section 23701d of the R&T Code.
7. Any amendment to these Articles of Organization or the Operating Agreement of the Limited Liability Company shall be consistent with Section 214 of the R&T Code.
8. To the fullest extent permitted by law, for the purpose of qualifying for the Welfare Exemption under the rules of the California Board of Equalization, this Limited Liability Company is prohibited from merging or converting into a for-profit entity.
9. The Limited Liability Company shall not distribute any of its assets to any member who ceases to be a Qualifying Organization.”
