ATTACHMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION 617 NORTH SYCAMORE AVENUE HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION INC.

This corporation is formed to manage an apartment building (the "Property") owned by the Association members as tenants in common.
