7. Additional Article Provisions:

- 7a. The liability of the directors of the corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated to the fullest extent permissible under California law.
- 7b. The corporation is authorized to provide indemnification of agents, as that term is defined in Section 317 of the California General Corporation Law, in excess of that expressly permitted by said Section 317 under any bylaw, agreement, vote of shareholders or disinterested directors or otherwise, to the fullest extent such indemnification may be authorized hereby, subject to the limits on such excess indemnification set forth in Section 204 of the California General Corporation Law.

The corporation is further authorized to provide insurance for agents as set forth in Section 317 of the California Corporations Code, provided that, in cases where the corporation owns all or a portion of the shares of the company issuing the insurance policy, the company and/or the policy must meet one of the two sets of conditions set forth in Section 317, as amended.
- 7d. Any repeal or modification of the foregoing provisions of Articles 7.b or 7.c by the shareholders of this corporation shall not adversely affect any right or protection of an agent of this corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification.
