## **ARTICLE 7**

The liability of the Directors of this Corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated to the fullest extent permissible under California law.

## **ARTICLE 8**

This Corporation is authorized to provide indemnification of agents (as defined in Section 317 of the California Corporations Code) for breach of duty to the Corporation and its stockholders through bylaw provisions or through agreements with the agents, or both, in excess of the indemnification otherwise permitted by Section 317 of the California Corporations Code, subject to the limits of such excess indemnification set forth in Section 204 of the California Corporations Code.
