Attachment for Copperleaf Owners Association

This corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to its Members. It is intended to qualify as a homeowners association under the applicable provisions of Section 528 of the United States Internal Revenue Code (“**IRC**”) and of Section 23701t of the Revenue and Taxation Code of the State of California (“**R&TC**”), as each may be amended from time to time. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private individual except as expressly provided in IRC Section 528 and R&TC Section 23701t with respect to the acquisition, construction or provision for management, maintenance and care of the Project, other than by a rebate of excess assessments.

The corporation is to provide for management, administration, maintenance, preservation and architectural control of the Units and Common Area within the real property (“**Project**”) situated in the City of Napa, County of Napa, State of California, commonly known as Copperleaf at Riversound Residential according to that certain Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions of Copperleaf at Riversound Residential recorded or to be recorded with respect to the Project in the Official Records of the County of Napa, State of California.

The rights of Members, number of Members, manner of election of the Directors and all other matters concerning the operation and governance of the corporation shall be as set forth in the Bylaws.

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation shall require the affirmative vote or written assent of the Directors and Members as follows:

A. Fifty-one percent (51%) of all Directors; and

B. 1. When a one class voting structure is in effect:

(i) Fifty-one percent (51%) of the total voting power of all Members; and

(ii) Fifty-one percent (51%) of the total voting power of all Members other than Declarant;
or

2. When a two class voting structure is in effect, fifty-one percent (51%) of the total voting power of each class of Members.

3. For purposes of the preceding votes, Class C Members shall have no voting rights except for their voting rights as Class A Members or Class B Members.
