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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

RMC Endowment, a California Nonprofit Religious Corporation

I. NAME

The name of the corporation is RMC Endowment.

II. ORGANIZATION AND PURPOSE

- Λ. This corporation is a Nonprofit Religious Corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Religious Corporation Law primarily for religious purposes.
- The specific purpose of this Corporation is to received and use funds for the benefit of the Russian Molokan Christian Spiritual Jumpers Cemetery Association Inc., a California nonprofit entity that is exempt under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(13) and which owns and operates a Christian cemetery located at 7201 Slauson Avenue in Commerce, California (the "Cemetery"). All monies will be used toward the care, maintenance and operations of the Cemetery.
- This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for the purposes within the C. meaning of Section 501(c)(13) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code").

LIMITATION OF CORPORATE ACTIVITY

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of lobbying or propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except as provided in Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distributing statements) on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

VI. IRREVOCABLE DEDICATION, DISSOLUTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

- A. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to the purposes set forth in Article II. No part of the net income and assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any of its directors or officers, or to the benefit of any private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.
- B. Upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational and/or religious purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(13). Priority shall be given to the Russian Molokan Cemetery Association, and then to some or all of the Molokan churches, or a combination thereof that is registered as a 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(13).

VII. MEMBERS

The corporation shall have no members.
