Requirement for Tax Exemption

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member or private shareholder, as provided by Internal Revenue Code, Section 501(c)(7).

Members

The corporation shall have members. The authorized number, qualifications for membership, classes of membership, if any, voting and other rights and privileges of the members, and the liability of members for fees, dues and assessments, and the method of collection thereof, shall be as set forth in the bylaws of the corporation.

Dissolution

Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts, obligations, and liabilities of the corporation and complying with the applicable provisions of the California Nonprofit Mutual Benefit Corporation Law, the remaining assets of this corporation shall be distributed among the members in accordance with their respective rights therein.

Limitation of Liability

The corporation is authorized to indemnify the directors, officers, and agents of the corporation to the fullest extent permissible under California law.
