ARTICLE I
Corporate Name

The name of the corporation is The Good Shepherd Endowment Fund.

ARTICLE II
Business Address

Purpose Statement

This corporation is a religious corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Religious Corporation Law exclusively for religious purposes.

ARTICLE V
Membership

This corporation has no members.

ARTICLE VI
Additional Statements

- a. The specific purpose of this corporation is to fund and support the ministry of The Parish of the Good Shepherd, a Christian church.
- b. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes within the meaning of Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3).
- c. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall


not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

- d. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to the purposes in Article 4 hereof and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.
- e. Upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to Fuller Theological Seminary in Pasadena, California, a nonprofit corporation that is tax-exempt under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3). If the remaining assets of the corporation cannot be distributed to Fuller Theological Seminary, then the remaining assets shall be distributed to Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary in Hamilton, Massachusetts, a nonprofit corporation that is tax-exempt under IRC § 501(c)(3). If the remaining assets cannot be distributed to either seminary, then the remaining assets shall be distributed to another nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, and/or religious purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under IRC § 501(c)(3).
