ATTACHMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

TRANQUIL SOUL THERAPY, AN INDIVIDUAL, MARRIAGE, AND FAMILY COUNSELING CORPORATION

DIRECTORS AND AGENTS INDEMNITY

The liability of the directors of the corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated to the fullest extent permissible under California law.

The corporation is authorized to provide indemnification of agents (as defined in Section 317 of the Corporations Code) for breach of duty to the corporation and its stockholders through bylaw provisions or through agreements with the agents, or both, in excess of the indemnification otherwise permitted by Section 317 of the Corporations Code, subject to the limits on such excess indemnification set forth in Section 204 of the Corporations Code.

SHARES BUY-SELL AGREEMENT

If proceedings for dissolution of the corporation to which Corporations Code Section 2000 applies are instituted, the provisions of any Buy-Sell or Buy-Out Agreement then in effect among the corporation's shareholders shall govern and supersede any provisions of Section 2000 inconsistent therewith, to the extent required to enforce such agreement.
