## Attachment to Articles of Incorporation for Omnis Inclusivus Fitness

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The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are:

A. To promote charitable purposes by providing:

- i. creating a fitness environment for underprivileged athletes, the elderly, and special need individuals who otherwise may not be able to exercise on a regular basis;
- ii. offering access to fitness equipment, weights, and workout space to such individuals on a sliding scale basis;

B. To promote educational purposes by teaching the above individuals how to take care of their bodies utilizing a variety of fitness techniques; and

C. To engage in any lawful activity in furtherance of the above purposes, but in no event will the corporation engage in any activity prohibited to corporations exempt from federal taxation under Section 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code."

### PERSONAL LIABILITY

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The liability of directors of the corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated to the fullest extent permissible under California law.

### INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall have the power to indemnify any agent of the corporation to the fullest extent permissible under California law
