



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

I

The name of this corporation is: Villa Siena Auxiliary. The name of the existing unincorporated association now being incorporated by the filing of these Articles is Villa Siena Auxiliary.

II

This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.

III

The specific purposes of this corporation are to enrich and enhance the lives of the residents of the Villa Siena Senior Living Community by addressing their spiritual, social, and emotional needs.

VI

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended (or any successor statute). Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation, and the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended (or any successor statute), or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, (or any successor statute).

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VII

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private person.


VIII

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to the Daughters of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul Province of the West, provided that it is then in existence and if it then qualifies as a tax-exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or any future corresponding provision). If Daughters of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul Province of the West is no longer in existence or no longer qualifies under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or any future corresponding provision), then the assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under IRC Section 501(c)(3) (or any successor statute).

IX

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.


